Cynthia Duncan became head of USCIB's Carnet Operations in February 2000, before which she was responsible for Carnet marketing and sales. She supervises a headquarters staff of documentation, marketing and claims processing specialists as well as a national network of Carnet service providers. Ms. Duncan is Deputy Chair of the World ATA Carnet Council, based in Paris, a member of the New York District Export Council and the Steering Committee of World Trade Week in New York City. She previously served in a number of other capacities at USCIB, including as vice president for membership.

In 1968, USCIB was appointed by the U.S. Customs Service to act as the U.S. guaranteeing and issuing association for the ATA Carnet service, a worldwide system (administered by the International Chamber of Commerce) enabling temporary, duty-free imports for trade shows, commercial samples and professional equipment. USCIB currently issues some 16,000 of these "merchandise passports" annually.

Ms. Duncan holds a bachelor's degree from the State University of New York at Fredonia and an MBA from Pace University in New York City, and has studied at the University of Grenoble, France.
